

# Concussion Policy

- In the event that a competitor receives a blow to the head, the Center Referee must stop time and examine the competitor for any symptoms of dizziness or disorientation. If the Center feels ANY cause for concern, they should stop the match and immediately call for the Chief Medic AND the Tournament Chairman for evaluation.
- If the Chief Medic determines there was a concussion, the competitor will be required to withdraw.
- The Tournament Director will speak with the judges to determine if the contact was due to an infraction or excessive force in order to determine the winner of the match.
